STRONG, LOCAL REPRESENTATION TORONTO-ST. PAUL'S CAN COUNT ON

Only Jess Spindler Can Defeat Doug Ford in Toronto-St. Paul's

Toronto - Today, Jess Spindler, Liberal Candidate for Toronto-St. Paul's made a commitment to stand up for education, childcare, and tenant's rights as MPP for Toronto-St. Paul's. She was joined by Josh Matlow, City Councillor, Ward 22, Toronto- St. Paul's and Jennifer Arp, Ward 8 TDSB Trustee.

"Serving and advocating for others in my community is what I'm passionate about and what I'm best at. I know how to stand up for people. And that's what we need and expect government to do, too," said Spindler. "I believe it is time for a new generation of MPPs to take a seat in the Legislature, and I am confident that as your representative at Queen's Park, when I speak up for our community, we will be heard."

As MPP for Toronto-St. Paul's, Jess will introduce a private member's bill to ban above guideline rent increases (AGIs) in the province, which would directly benefit the almost 60% of people in this riding who are renters.

"Toronto's rental market is rapidly becoming unaffordable for many residents, and there's a real need for further rent control in Ontario, especially when it comes to AGIs," said Matlow. "Rent control is at risk if Doug Ford has his way. Electing Jess in Toronto-St. Paul's is our best bet at stopping the years of chaos, dishonesty, waste and division Doug Ford would bring to Ontario, just like he did at City Hall."

Born and raised in St. Paul's, Jess Spindler is a fresh face for the riding. She is running to protect the gains the province has made, and she will bring a new perspective to the Ontario Liberal Party and to Queen's Park as she advocates on behalf of the community.

"This race is about strong, local representation and about electing someone who will work hard for Toronto-St. Paul's and be an effective representative for the community at Queen's Park," said Jennifer Arp, Ward 8 TDSP Trustee. "Jess knows the importance of a good education and will fight to make sure that our classrooms have the resources they need to set our students up for success."
